Translational Medicine Explained (TMEx)

The TMEx Winter School consists of an introductory e learning (~12 hours student investment time) followed by a 5-day face-to-face workshop. The course is intended for PhD students in the second half of their PhD and early postdocs who are involved in biomedical research.

The course is kindly supported by La Caixa Foundation and the Vall d'Hebron Research Institute (VHIR) and will be hosted in one of Barcelona's great Catalan Modernisme gems: the Palau Macaya.
